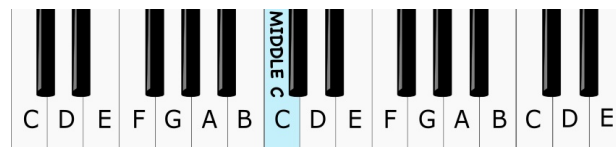


Lesson 8: More right hand notes

Right hand plays middle C

There are lots of Cs on the keyboard, but the most important one is middle C. As we have learnt before, Middle C (like every C) is just to the left of a group of 2 black keys.

In the treble clef it is written like this. It is on its own small line, **just above the stave**.



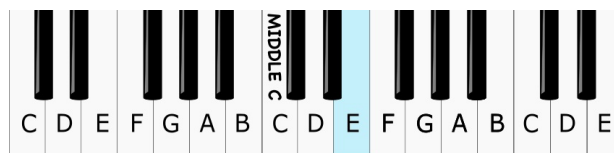
In the next two tunes your right hand will need to move position (up and down the keys). Look for the asterisk which will warn you when it needs to do this.

Let's C now!

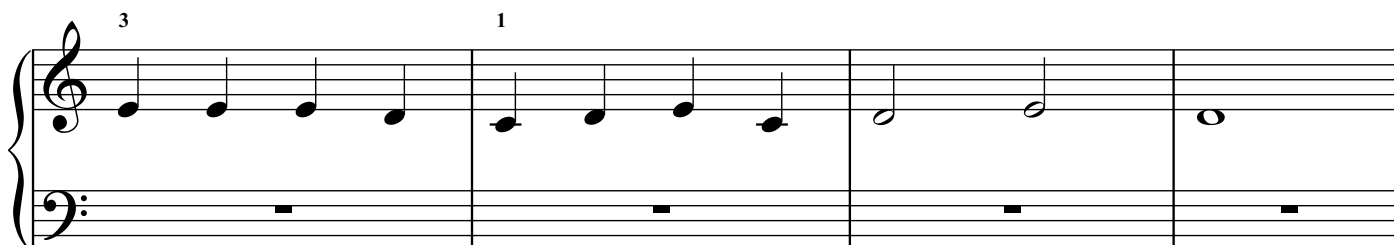
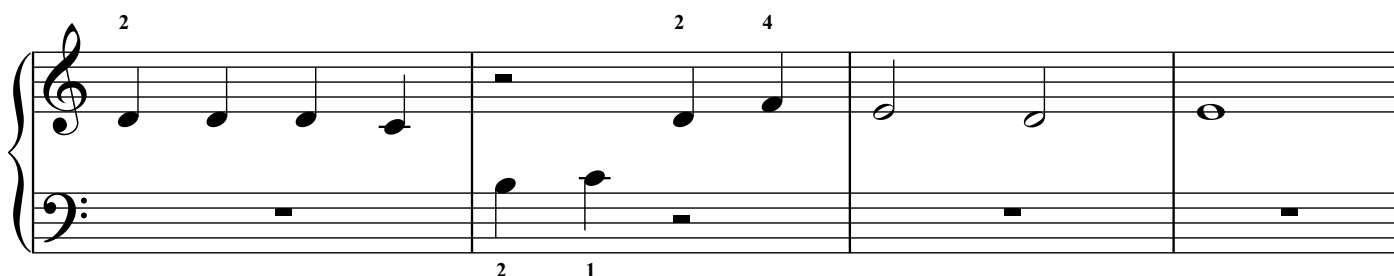
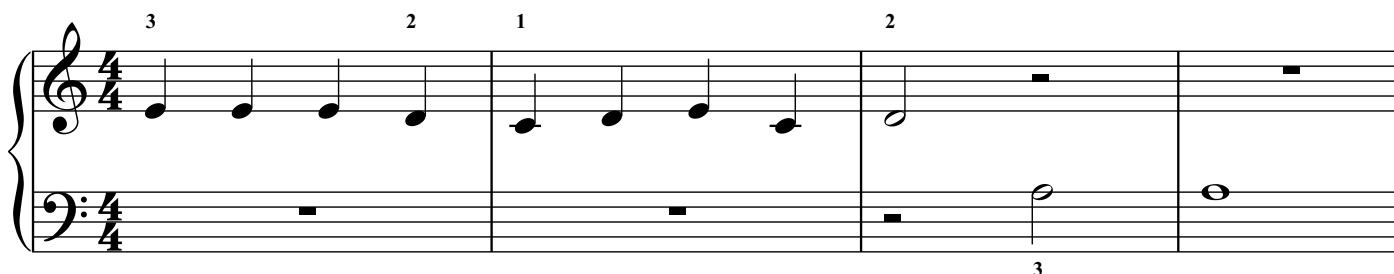
Circle
